We are telling you about our Privacy Policy, so you know what information we collect, why we collect it and what we do with it. Scope:

Information We Collect:

JCPC may collect certain information when you access or use the Website. This information may include location information, IP address, device identifier, browser type, domain name, operating system, information about your use of the Website, internet service provider, pages that you visit before and after using the Website, the date and time of your visit, information about the links you click and pages you view within the Website, and other standard server log information. We may use various tools such as cookies web beacons and other online tracking technologies to collect this information. We may combine certain automatically collected information with other information we obtain about you, which may include information we obtain from third parties. We collect your information from the following sources:

- Information you give us, such as during registration on the Website, Website interactions, such as rating products, joining a forum, customer service operations, purchasing, scheduling, surveys, download of a software update, and other Website transactions;

Disclosure to Third Parties

At times, JCPC may make certain personal information available to our strategic partners or affiliates that work with JCPC to provide products and services, or that help JCPC market to customers. Personal information will only be shared by JCPC to provide or improve our products, services and advertising; it will not be shared with third parties for their marketing purposes or any other use. We may share your Personal Information connection with an asset sale, merger, bankruptcy, or other business transaction.

Cookies and Other Technologies
